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ABOUT THE SENDAI FRAMEWORK MONITOR

In March 2018, the Sendai Framework Monitor¹ was launched by [United Nations Office for Disaster Risk Reduction \(UNDRR\)](#) as the official tool to report on global and national implementation progress of the Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction 2015-2030 (SFDRR)

Strong accountability is one of the cornerstones of the Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction. A set of 38 indicators, recommended by an Open-ended Intergovernmental Expert Working Group, will track progress in implementing the seven targets of the Sendai Framework as well as its related dimensions reflected in the Sustainable Development Goals 1, 11 and 13.

Sendai Framework and Sustainable Development Goals (SDG)

The Sendai Framework targets and indicators contribute to measuring disaster-related goals and targets of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, in particular SDG 1 – End poverty in all its forms everywhere, 11 – Make cities and human settlements inclusive, safe, resilient and sustainable and 13 – Take urgent action to combat climate change and its impacts.
